Adrian Justin Rawlins (born 27 March 1958) is an English actor who is probably best known for playing Arthur Kidd in The Woman in Black (1989) and James Potter in the Harry Potter films.

School in Stoke-on-Trent and the Stoke VI Form College. He then went on to train in art then subsequently acting at Crewe and Alsager College, now Manchester Met.

#### Career

Rawlins has appeared in several films including <u>Wilbur Wants to Kill Himself</u>, and also has a pivotal role in the <u>Harry Potter film series</u> as <u>Harry Potter's father James Potter</u>. Onstage, he has appeared in <u>Her Naked Skin</u> (2008, <u>National Theatre</u>). He played Richard Collingsworth in the <u>1989 TV serial</u> version of <u>The Ginger Tree</u>, opposite <u>Samantha Bond</u>. He also starred in *The Woman in Black* which was made for television and aired at Christmas 1989.
